

The Eurail Flexi Pass lets you travel by train on a specific number of days that you choose to travel on during the validity of the pass.

Travel days do not have to be consecutive and you decide during your trip when you use them.

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use.

Countries you can explore are **Austria, Belgium, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Ireland (Republic), Italy, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Montenegro, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and Turkey.**

## Eurail Global Flexi Pass Information

### General information:

- Unlimited rail travel in 31 European countries.
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively

### Extra information:

**Free Child Offer:** Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travels free for each paying adult or senior. The free child offer must be requested at the time of booking the adult or senior pass. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.

**Bonuses:** Passholders receive free\* or discounted Bonus Offers which include selected ferry crossings between:

- Italy and Greece: Brindisi-Corfu-Igoumenitsa-Patras operated by HML or Blue Star Ferries. A summer surcharge must be paid from June 10 to September 30. Reservations are recommended for July & August.
- Sweden and Finland: Helsinki-Mariehamn-Stockholm; Turku-Mariehamn-Stockholm; Vasa-Umea operated by Silja Line. Reservations are recommended from June to August.
- Finland and Germany: Rostock-Helsinki.

## Details

- For Flexi Pass holders, free bonuses may only be used on dates that you have added in the Travel Calendar on your Eurail Pass. All other bonuses do not need to be used on a date that you have added to your Travel Calendar.
- For Continuous Pass holders, bonuses can be used on any date that your Eurail Pass is valid.
- Instructions on how to redeem a bonus are detailed in the list. Some bonuses (ferry journeys in particular), require advance bookings.
- Offers are subject to change or be discontinued at any time. Therefore, we recommend checking first if the bonus is still offered by contacting the individual company or Rail Europe.

## Payment & Ticketing

### Conditions:

- Residents of Europe, Turkey and the Russian Federation are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Pass.
- Citizens and residents of the United Kingdom are not eligible to travel with a Eurail Pass.
- Passes must be validated prior to first day of use.
- Passes must be validated within 11 months of issue date.
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding the first train / first use of a travel bonus.
- Free Child Offer: Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travel free for each paying adult or senior. The free child offer must be requested at the time of booking the adult or senior pass. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.
- Travel bonuses may necessitate usage of a travel day. The full list of bonuses can be found in the Eurail Travellers Guide.
- Certain trains may transit through a country not covered by the pass. In that case an additional ticket must

be purchased.

- Seat reservation fees are an additional charge and are not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
- Night Train rule:
  - This rule means that you only need to use 1 **travel** day when you **travel** on **night trains** in Europe
  - Enter the date of departure on your Eurail pass travel calendar
  - If your night train departs after midnight this still counts as day of departure

We also recommend that you take out suitable travel insurance to cover (as a minimum) the costs incurred if you cancel your trip.

## Cancellation & Amendments

**Conditions:**

- A \$20 per pass fee applies for amendments to unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A fee of \$30 per person, per pass applies to totally unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- No partial refunds.
- Eurail Passes cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
