

## Explore Poland on one of Eastern Europe's most extensive rail networks!

The **Poland Eurail Pass** is a flexi pass valid for unlimited travel on any **3, 4, 5, 6 & 8 days** in **1 month**. Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use.

### Poland Eurail Pass Information

#### Things to note:

- To start using the pass it must be validated at a European train station before your first journey.
- Each further day of travel must be entered on your pass before you board the train.
- Free Child Offer: Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travels free for each paying adult. The free child offer is NOT valid in conjunction with a Senior fare. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.

#### Which Polish services is a rail pass valid on?

The Eurail Poland Pass is accepted on the following:

- PKP - dependent railway company PKP Intercity JSC and is valid with the following companies owned by local government:
  - Przewozy Regionalne (Regional Services)
  - Koleje Dolnoslaskie (with the exception of "Pociąg do kultury")
  - Direct trains running from Berlin to Wrocław, mostly at weekends as well as "KD Specjal" trains)
  - PKP Szybka Kolej Miejska (SKM) w Trójmieście

## Payment & Ticketing

#### Conditions:

- Residents of Europe, UK, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria and Tunisia are not eligible to purchase or use an Poland Rail Pass.
- Passes must be validated within 11 months of issuing date by a railway official in Poland.
- Passes must be validated prior to boarding first train/ first use of travel bonus.
- Seat reservation fees are an additional charge and not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
- Free Child Offer: Two children aged 4-11 years inclusive travels free for each paying adult. The free child offer is NOT valid in conjunction with a Senior fare. Additional children aged 4-11 years purchase a Youth fare. Children under 4 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed. Seat reservation fees still apply.
- Night Train rule:
  - This rule means that you only need to use 1 travel day when you travel on night trains in Europe
  - Enter the date of departure on your Eurail pass travel calendar

- If your night train departs after midnight this still counts as day of departure
- Comprehensive conditions of use can be found on the ticket cover

We also recommend that you take out suitable travel insurance to cover (as a minimum) the costs incurred if you cancel your trip.

## Cancellation & Amendments

### Conditions:

- A \$20 per pass fee applies for amendments to unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A fee of \$30 per person, per pass applies to totally unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- No partial refunds.
- Eurail Passes cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
