Trenitalia offers direct rail connections between Italian cities and neighboring countries.

There is no greater experience, or more beautiful sight, than arriving in Venice by train, exiting the station and seeing the Grand Canal before your eyes. Rail travel in Italy has never been so easy.

Access to trains

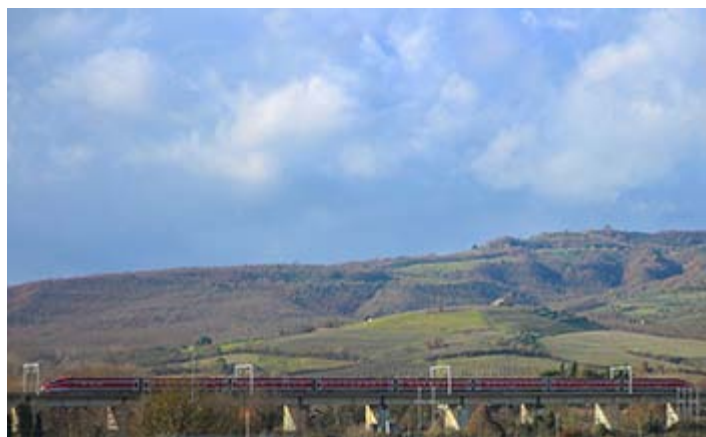
Trenitalia close their train doors 1 minute prior to departure.

- Travellers must board their train at least one minute prior to the train's departure.
- At one minute prior to departure the train doors will be closed, thereafter boarding will not be possible.
- This applies to Frecciarossa, Frecciargento, Frecciabianco, Intercity and IntercityNight trains .

Train Types

Le Frecce

Trenitalia has 3 types of high speed trains, referred to collectively as “Le Frecce”.



Frecciarossa

Connects Milan, Bologna, Rome, Naples, Florence, Venice, Bari, Trieste and Salerno on the high speed line.

Frecciarossa 1000 trains travel up to 300km/h.

Frecciargento

Tilting train that run on high-speed and conventional tracks.

Runs on conventional lines outside of the high speed network

InterCity & Regional

InterCity & Regional trains connect major cities and smaller towns in Italy.

Onboard

- First class: 2+1 reclining seats. Not all Regional trains offer First class.
- Second class: 2+2 reclining seats
- Power outlets

Reservations

- Italy offers e-Tickets & paper tickets.
- Italy E-tickets can be purchased 180 days prior to the train departure date.
- Paper tickets can be purchased 120 days prior to the train departure date.
- Reservations are compulsory for high speed (Le Freccie & InterCity) trains. Reservations are not possible for regional services.

With a Rail Pass

- Rail pass holders are welcome, a seat reservation fee is additional.
- Passholder fares are paper tickets only (no e-Tickets).
- Passholder fares are for passengers carrying a Eurail Global Pass, Eurail Select Pass (incl. Italy) / Eurail

France-Italy pass / Eurail Greece-Italy / Eurail Italy Pass.

Child Fares

- On high speed trains, the child age is 4 and 14 inclusive on the train departure date. Children under 4 years travel free when sharing a paying adults seat/bed. NOTE: Child Age is 4 and 11 inclusive on regional services.
