First class

- Comfortable and large seats
- Leather seats

Second class

- Convenient and comfortable seats
- Access to a full service restaurant car with local specialties as well as a wide selection of soft drinks, wines and beer

Reservations

- Brenner EuroCity trains can be reserved up to 180 days in prior to the train departure date
- Reservations are compulsory and included in the ticket cost (additional for rail pass holders)

With a Rail Pass

- Rail pass holders must reserve a seat, for an additional cost
- **Pass 1:** Applies for holders of any pass covering the whole route. Also valid for holders of a German Rail Pass when traveling on direct trains Munich to Bolzano/Bozen, Trento, Verona, Bologna or Venice
- **Pass 2:** Applies for holders of any pass covering at least two of the countries traveled through
- **Pass 3:** Applies for holders of any pass covering at least one of the countries traveled through
- The class of service must match the class of service of the Rail Pass
- Customers are not allowed to purchase a 1st class Passholder with a 2nd class pass

Child, Youth & Senior Fares

- Child age is 4-11 years inclusive
- Youth age is between 12-25 years inclusive
- Senior age is over 60 years
