

If you're planning to be based in London or the Southeast of England this is the ideal Pass. The **BritRail London Plus Pass** is the convenient way to see the south east of England. Frolic by the sea of Brighton, walk with Majesty at Windsor or soak up the intellectual atmosphere of Oxford and Cambridge.

The **BritRail London Plus Pass** is a Flexi Pass valid for unlimited travel for any **3, 4 & 8 days in 1 month**.

Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use.

**Extended Boundaries:** In order to deliver a greater value experience, the boundaries of the BritRail London Plus Pass now include Bath, Bristol and Stratford-Upon-Avon.

## BritRail London Plus Pass Information

### General

- To start using the pass it must be validated at a British train station before your first journey.
- Each further day of travel must be entered on your pass before you board the train.
- **This pass does not cover the London Underground**

### Features

- The Britrail London Plus Pass is valid for travel on the participating train operators services in the South East area of England surrounding London (a detailed map is available on the Britrail Ticket cover)
- Boundary stations are: Bath, Bristol, Harwich, Kings Lynn, Huntingdon, Bedford, Long Buckby, Stratford-upon-Avon, Worcester Foregate, Bedwyn, Salisbury, Bristol Temple Meads and Weymouth.
- Valid on overland trains
- Not valid on London underground
- The Britrail London Plus Pass is valid on the Heathrow Express, Stansted Express or Gatwick Express. Pass needs to be validated and will require use of a travel day.

## Payment & Ticketing

### Conditions:

- Age 5 and under travel for free if not occupying a seat or bed.
- Ages 5-15 qualify for child fares (50% off the adult fare).
- Permanent residents of the UK are not eligible to purchase or use a Britrail London Plus Pass.
- Passes must be validated within 11 months of issue date.
- Passes are actual travel documents and do not need to be exchanged, and must be validated prior to boarding the first train.
- Any onward journey made outside the Britrail London Plus Pass area boundary must be paid in advance

before boarding the relevant train i.e: a valid ticket must be purchased, otherwise penalty fees will be incurred.

- Reservations are not inclusive in the cost of the pass and can only be made locally.
- 7:00pm rule does not apply.

## Cancellation & Amendments

### Conditions:

- A \$20 per pass fee applies for amendments to unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A fee of \$30 per person, per pass + carrier penalty fee applies to totally unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- No partial refunds.
- Britrail Passes cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
